More Latest Packers News 1921 Green Bay Packers The Dope Sheet Inaugural Issue. Call it the Book of Genesis for the storied Green Bay Packers franchise, the document that started everything, and the one that stands at the end of the team's archive in both rarity and meaning. For many of even the most ousted and well-known package collectors, the offer will serve as the first to notice that this important relic even exists, and we are quite sure that the issue listed here represents a full population of survivors. The better part of the century, which has been since the brief beginning of the 1920s, was printed in green bay, and the delicate newspaper stock that served as a medium ensured that all but the tiny hand were lost to the time. And once again, we stress that this is just an inauguration issue. Curly Lambeau, the team's founder and six-time NFL champion, plays the appropriate role of cover boy for this print debut, alongside an article trumpet: The American Professional Football League is football, but either the American League or the National League is for baseball. The APFL would have changed its name to a well-known national football league in 1922. Page 2 begins with an article titled A Word About the Dope Sheet, by J. Emmett Clair, Mgr. Acme Packers Football Club. He explains that on Wednesday of this week, arrangements for the publication of this weekly sports period were finalized. The edition had to get to the printers on Friday to be in your hands today. For this very good reason this number is not shown as future figures will be, nor is there as much close-up about football in general and in Green Bay in particular as we expected it to publish. At the center of the eight-page publication appears a sheet with a score of 40-0 over the visiting Chicago Cornell-Hamburgs in what is recognized (and listed on page one) as the third game of professional Packers, which was spotted in pencil by the original owner of The List. Records of participation in this competition have been lost in history, but those of the Packers from 1921 for which ticket sales were recorded range from just 2,000 to 7,000, another factor in the intense rarity of the Dope Sheets in the modern hobby. The situation is quite remarkable for this delicate treasure, with only a small degree of edge cooling and chipping for the report, but none of the severe stain, lynchings or tearing common to the sharp few Dope Leaves known to exist. In any event, those collectors who understand the importance and sms of this offer will not find a The Green Bay Packers finished the 2018 campaign with a 6-9-1 record, which was only green bay's fourth losing season in the last 26 seasons. Six of the Packers' nine defeats this season were by eight points or less, three for three or fewer points. Green Bay started the season by coming back 20 points down and beating the Chicago Bears 24-23 in week 1. It was the second-largest comeback victory in team history at Lambeau Field (21 against New Orleans 17 Sept. 1989) and only the fifth time in franchise history that Green Bay posted a comeback victory of 20-plus points. In Week 2, the Packers and Minnesota Vikings pulled off 29-29, making Green Bay's first wild-card game since Nov 24, 2013, which was also against Minnesota at Lambeau Field (26-26). It marked only the third non-consistent match between the two teams in the series' 58-year history (1961-2018). After losing to Washington in Week 3, the Packers beat the Buffalo Bills by registering their first shutout (22-0) after a 31. 31, 2010, at the N.Y. Jets (9-0) and the first shutout posted by the Packers at Lambeau Field since their 26-0 victory over Detroit 26-0 18, 2009. The eighth road loss against the Lions in Week 5 was followed by a 49th-minute victory over the San Francisco 49ers at 3:30 p.m. on Monday night. K Mason Crosby gave all four of his field goals (29, 39, 51, 27) and all three extra points, including the 27-yard FG as the time that gave him the FG winner in each of the last three seasons (2016 in Chicago, 2017 against Cincinnati). The Packers have struggled with four road games in the five weeks after Week 8. The two-point defeat by the Los Angeles Rams was followed by a two-point loss to the New England Patriots. In Green Bay's first home game in nearly four weeks, the Packers recorded 195 yards on 25 stretchers (7.8 yards) and tied a 31-12 victory over the Miami Dolphins with six sacks. Green Bay lost to the Seattle Seahawks by three points on Thursday night' game, which marked the Packers' third game in 12 days. Week 12 at Minnesota brought Green Bay a seven-point loss. After a three-point loss to the Arizona Cardinals at Lambeau Field, the Packers broke up with principal Mike McCarthy and offensive coordinator Joe Philbin was named interim coach. Green Bay posted 34 points in Philbin's first game, beating the Atlanta Falcons with 14 points at home. Rodgers' streak of consecutive no-int attempts ended with 402 in week 15 of the loss to Chicago. For the longest streak in NFL history, he passed Patriots QB Tom Brady (358 in 2010-2011). Green Bay rebounded in week 16, with Rodgers making 37 of 55 pass attempts (67.3 percent) for 442 yards with two touchdowns and a zero interception for a score of 103.8 passers and had two rushing TDs in the Packers' 44-38 win over the New York Jets. Rodgers is the only player in NFL history with at least 400 passing yards, two passes for touchdowns and two rushing touchdowns in a game. It is also October 2, 2011, against Denver (408 passing yards, four touchdowns and two touchdowns). In week 16, Green Bay came back 15 points down in the fourth quarter to beat the Jets. For the first time in the team's history, it marked that the Packers came in at 15-plus points in the fourth quarter in two games of the season (Week 1 against Chicago), according to the Elias Sports Bureau. Green Bay had a total of 35 first downs in week 16, the second-most in franchise history for just 37 in Philadelphia on Nov 11, 1962. The Packers would lose the season finale against the Lions and finish 2-2 under Philbin. The Packers finished 2nd with 15 assists (Seattle, 11) in 2018, the third-fewest in the team's season (13 in 2014 and 14 in 2011).
